

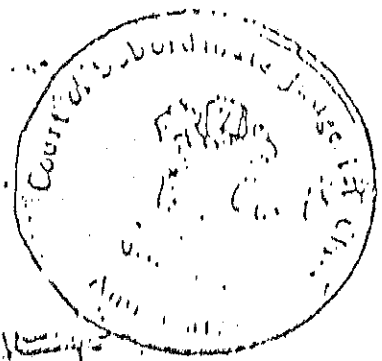

(d) To provide instruction in (i) English and other modern languages (ii) Arts and (iii) Sciences, both theoretical and applied, including Medicine, Engineering etc.;

II. To provide means for giving technical, industrial, commercial and vocational education;

III. To affiliate and manage institutions having objects similar to those mentioned in Articles I and II above; and

IV. To do all such other things as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above objects of any one of them.


Regulations

1. The expression "Arya Samaj" "Arya Sabhasad" and "Antrang Sabha" wherever used in these regulations, shall, unless the contrary appears from the context, be understood to have the same meaning as are attached to these expressions in the Upiyams of the Arya Samaj as they existed in 1883 except that:—

(i) for the purpose of returning representatives to the Antrang Sabha, every group shall consist of at least ten Arya Sabhasads; and

(ii) in order to be entitled to a right of representation on the D.A.V. College Society, such Arya Samaj must have existed for more than twelve months and must consist of ten or more Arya Sabhasads.

2. In these Regulations the expression "Member of the Arya Samaj" shall mean only that person who is certified as

**Regulations of the D.A.V. College Trust and
Management Society**

(Registered under the Societies' Registration Act, 1860)

Aims and Objects

1. A Society for establishing and managing in Punjab and elsewhere institutions (a) to commemorate the memory of Swami Dayanand Saraswati and (b) to propagate the teachings of the Vedic Dharma, is constituted and registered under the Societies' Registration Act XXI of 1860.

2. The said Society is designate "The Dayanand Anglo-Vedic College Trust & Management Society." The Registered Office of the Society shall be at New Delhi.

3. The objects of the Society are :—

1. To establish in Punjab and elsewhere institutions such as colleges, schools, boarding houses, ashrams, etc. with the following purposes :—

(a) To encourage, improve and enforce the study of Hindi ;

(b) To encourage and enforce the study of classical Sanskrit and the Vedas ;

(c) To encourage the theory and practice of Ayurveda and

such by the President or the Secretary of the Arya Samaj to which he belongs. Provided that in the absence of such certificate, the President of D.A.V. College Trust & Management Society, if he is otherwise satisfied, may accept such person's declaration in writing that he is a member of the Arya Samaj.

3. The Society shall comprise all those persons who have donated Rs. 250/- or more in one lump sum to its funds of a permanent nature and are members of any Arya Samaj affiliated to the Arya Pradeshiik Pratishthi Sabha, but subject to the approval of the President, D.A.V. College Managing Committee, New Delhi, provided that the Society may waive the condition of affiliation with the A.P.P. Sabha in case of any specified Arya Samaj or Arya Samajes.

4. Every member of the Dayanand Anglo-Vedic College Trust & Management Society shall pay at least Rs. 12/- as yearly subscription or Rs. 100/- for life.

5. No member of the Society shall be entitled to vote at a meeting of the Society, unless he has paid monthly subscription, at the rate specified in Regulation 4 for the twelve months preceding the date of the meeting or since the date of his membership, whichever is less, and his name shown in the register of members prepared for the year under Regulation 50 (fifty).

6. Subject to the control of the Dayanand Anglo-Vedic College Trust & Management Society and to such Regulations as have been passed by or may from time to time be passed by the said Society, the affairs of Society shall be conducted, its objects carried out and the institutions under its control managed by a Managing Committee which shall be composed of

- (a) Members returned from the Arya Samajes in accordance with the provisions of Regulations 7 (seven) and 8 (eight).
